AIR TRANSPORTATION: International air is not included. If you choose to purchase your international air prior to 90 days before departure, please contact our office first. *Journeys of the Mind/BAS* cannot be held responsible for cancellation penalties related to domestic or international airline tickets. HOTELS: 4-star as indicated based on two persons sharing twin-bedded room with private bath and/or shower. *Journeys of the Mind/BAS* reserves the right to substitute hotels in similar categories. SINGLE ACCOMMODATIONS: *Journeys of the Mind/BAS* will endeavor to arrange for a congenial roommate, this is not always possible or recommended; a single supplement will be charged when required or requested.

MEALS: Breakfast daily and as indicated.

TRANSFERS: Complimentary international arrival and departure transfers are provided plus group transfers.

SIGHTSEEING/TRANSPORTATION: All sightseeing tours described provided by best available air-conditioned motor coaches, or other vehicles depending upon circumstances at the time of tour operation. All entrance fees to places visited in the itinerary are included.

LECTURER/GUIDES: Local guides throughout, Dr. Swanson Seminars plus on site enrichment as outlined in itinerary.
